In Memoriam ~ Raymundo José Chico (1930 - 2019)

It is with great sadness that we report that Ray Chico, veteran DWPC member Beverly Chico's loving husband, has passed away. Ray often accompanied Beverly to club events, and was always an enthusiastic and cheerful supporter. He will be missed.

Raymundo José Chico was born on September 17, 1930 in Hernando, Cordoba, Argentina, the son of Jesus and Magdalena (Giraud) Chico. He came to the United States in 1954, and married Beverly Ann Berghaus, July 25, 1959. The Chico family included 4 children: Christian, Gregory, R. Matthew, and Marta.



Ray was an internationally esteemed metal mining geology and oil executive. He earned his doctorate in Geology from the University Nacional Córdoba, Argentina (1953), Master of Science in Mining Geology, Missouri School Mines and Metallurgy (1959), and Master of Arts in Economic Geology, Harvard University (1962). In 1979, Ray Chico established American Gold Minerals Corporation. He pursued worldwide mineral development, exploration, and investment through his successful firms Amada Mineral Corporation and Chico Investment Group.
