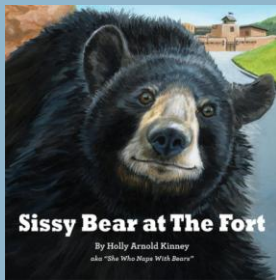
Sissy Bear at the Fort

At a young age, Holly spent time in the kitchen of The Fort, helping to run what would become a world renowned restaurant. The Colorado institution recently celebrated 50 years and remains one of the top culinary and historic

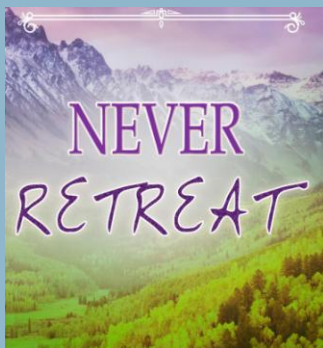
