**"The Fourth Estate - In Film + Conversation,"** is an exciting and timely new film series presented by the Denver Film Society in 2019. DWPC and Colorado Press Women are honored to be collaborating on the first program of the series, featuring a **special screening of "The Post,"** the Academy Award-nominated true story of a cover-up that spanned four U.S. Presidents. Following Daniel Ellsberg's leak of the Pentagon Papers, The Washington Post publisher Katherine Graham (Meryl Streep) and Editor Ben Bradlee (Tom Hanks) must decide how far to go to protect the freedom of the press.

**"Meet the NEW Press" panel discussion:** The film will be followed by a lively panel discussion on the present state and future of online journalism, featuring Denver's leading editors (all women, of course!):



**Dana Coffield, Senior Editor of *The Colorado Sun***, has been breaking a new trail to a sustainable business model for local journalism while editing Colorado's newest news source for the past 8 months. She previously worked for *The Denver Post* for 10 years, leaving as Senior Editor-News and prior to that working as its business editor for three years.



**Susan Greene, Editor of the *Colorado Independent***, previously worked 13 years for *The Denver Post* as a political reporter, national reporter and metro columnist after reporting for papers in California and Nevada. The Pulitzer prize-winning journalist has taken the helm of the statewide online news source, *The Colorado Independent*, since 2013.



**Ashley Dean, Assistant Editor and culture reporter at *Denverite***, the daily online local news source. She previously covered music and did copy editing for *The Denver Post*, the *Colorado Daily* and the *Daily Camera*. Her beat focuses on culture in the ways Denverites live and how our changing city is making it easier, harder or just plain different.

**Moderator - Patricia Calhoun co-founder and Editor of *Westword***, Denver's News and Arts Weekly. She founded the paper in 1977, after graduating from Cornell University, and has been the editor of the popular community paper (and now of the online edition) ever since. She is former president of the Association of Alternative Newsweeklies, and award-winning columnist.
