Dr. Martha Uribe is Senior Instructor at the School of Education and Human Development at the University of Colorado Denver, and author of *Todos Vamos A Estar Bien (We're Going to Be Alright)*.

As many as fifteen thousand children in the United States are placed in foster care due to detainment or deportation of a parent. The placement of children in protective care usually lasts as long as the legal proceedings, which could take months. Teachers have little idea of how to work with children with these kinds of emotional challenges. At present, there is a lack of research on the specific ways that the deportation of a parent shapes the children left behind. What we do know, however, is that the separation of families under these kinds of circumstances is certain to have adverse consequences for newborns, grade-school children, and adolescents alike.

Author Maria Uribe wrote *Todos Vamos A Estar Bien (We're Going to Be Alright)* after witnessing a four year-old crying in a classroom with worry about whether her family was in danger of deportation. Uribe thought long and hard about how a teacher might be able to help. Her illustrated children's book addresses the issues children of undocumented immigrants face. Uribe says, "As parents and educators, we can help all children understand what the children of undocumented immigrants are going through. We hope this book will help them see these children as very like them; with loving families, hopes, and dreams."
