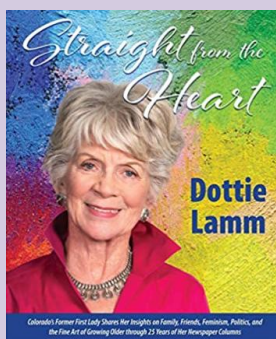
Our Meet & Greets are fun, casual sessions where members can get to know current board members.

In the meantime, please watch your weekly *eConnect* to find current information on all of our virtual events scheduled through the rest of the year. We look forward to seeing you on Zoom!

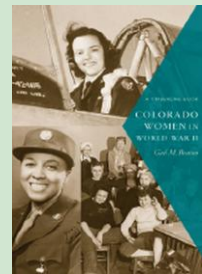
