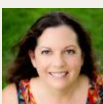

Every two years, the Colorado Women's Hall of Fame inducts up to ten exceptional contemporary and historical women nominated by the public into

the Hall. A total of 162 women have been inducted since the Hall's founding in 1985. The candidate must have strong ties to our state either through birth, residence, the lasting influences of her experiences in Colorado, or by having made her mark here. She must have made significant and enduring contributions to her field, elevated the status of women and helped open new frontiers for women and society, and inspired others, especially women and girls, by her example.
