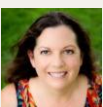

She must have: Made significant and enduring contributions to her field, elevated the status of women and helped open new frontiers for women and society, and inspired others, especially women and girls, by her example. 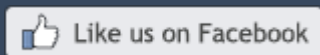
