DWPC hosts award-winning playwright Jeffrey Neuman for a dinner event centered around Denver theater today.

Neuman will talk about all things theater in Denver and include fun, informative glimpses into the joys and frustrations, the celebrations and the heartaches of being a playwright in Colorado and beyond. He'll also talk about Rough Draught Playwrights (RDP), a Denver-based company he co-founded.

Jeffrey is an award-winning playwright whose work has been performed at theaters and festivals across the United States, as well as in Australia and the U.K. He has worked as a director and dramatist for the Colorado Shakespeare Festival and the Denver Center for the Performing Arts. He also facilitates literary events for the Denver Post's *Pen & Podium* series.
