The contest opens Wednesday, January 1, 2020 with final deadline for entries Saturday, February 15. Awards reception is Saturday, April 4, for all entrants.

Entry fees are \$25 for fiction and nonfiction, \$20 for poetry. Cash prizes are \$125 for first place, \$75 for second place and \$50 for third place in each category.

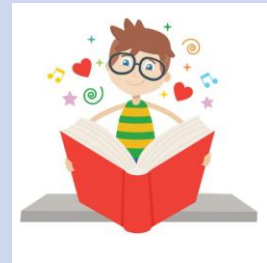
