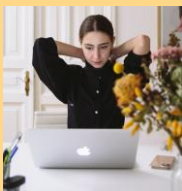
Thank you to all of you who have already renewed! If you haven't yet, here's how easy it is:

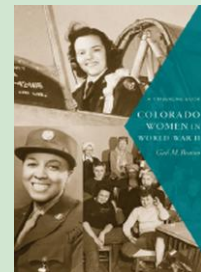
