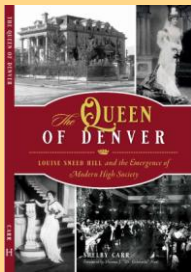
Registration is \$20, with scholarships available. The conference is also offering manuscript critiques for \$25.
