***Straight from the Heart***

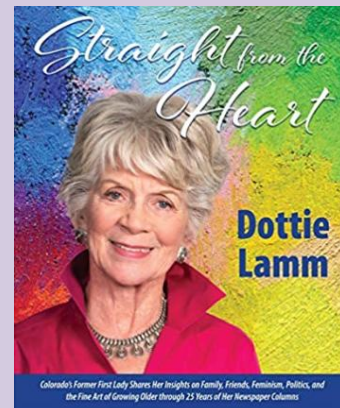
Virtual Sunday Salon via Zoom

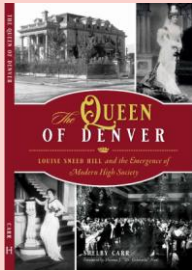
