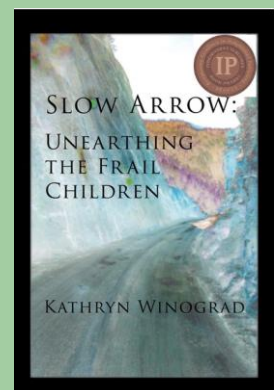

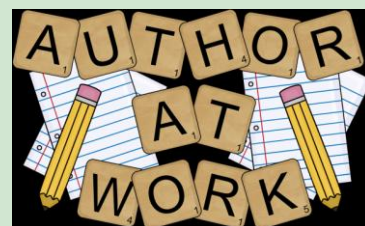
In Memoriam: Marilyn Stoddard
