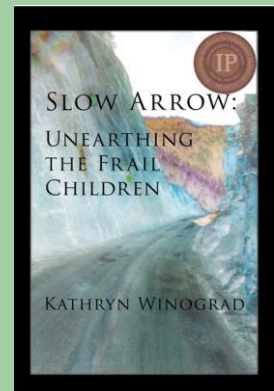

Creating the Braided Essay: A Journey into *Slow Arrow, Unearthing the Frail Children*

Against the backdrop of Teller County's Phantom Canyon, gold mines, and fossil quarries, Kathryn Winograd's newest collection of essays, *Slow Arrow, Unearthing the Frail Children*, discovers the connections between outer and inner landscapes through the form of the braided essay. Using excerpts of *Slow Arrow* as examples, Winograd will demonstrate the techniques for weaving together this beautiful form of the lyric essay. *Slow Arrow, Unearthing the Frail Children* received the Bronze Medal in Essay from the 2020 Independent Publishers Book Awards.

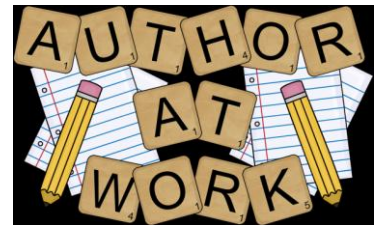
