Here are some details about the role:

- \*The chair can recruit a co-chair (or chair-in-training) as well as a publicity expert so you work with a small team of your choosing.
- \*Coordinate with The Gathering Place for no-fee submissions.
- \*Organize judging groups for the three categories: fiction, nonfiction, and poetry. If you haven't had the pleasure of serving as a judge for this contest, you're missing out as it's a fun way to get to know your fellow members.
- \*Host one seminar for judges on how to give feedback to entrants.


